2. WAIE Student Members: Must work in or volunteer with an international office. Submit a statement of purpose describing your involvement in international education.

#### **Professional and Support Staff:**

1. WAIE Professional Staff: Must work in an international education environment. Submit a statement of purpose describing your interest in the conference and how your participation will benefit you personally and professionally.
2. WAIE Support Staff: Must work in an international education office having some direct contact with students. Submit a letter of nomination from your supervisor.

You must submit payment for the conference fee at the time of registration. Awards will be reimbursed to Grant winners following the conference.
